## 3.1 Administrators' Reports

# Mr. Dodge, HS Principal

- Attended the NYSCOSS Conference as part of the Superintendent Development Program.
- 20 of our seniors attended the college fair at Houghton College with Mr. Kelley.
- Mr. Dodge provided an update about the gap analysis meetings that he has had with the Social Studies teachers.
- Mr. Dodge discussed the Sweethearts and Heroes which is a positive character building, anti-bullying assembly that will be held on October 13<sup>th</sup>. Belfast will be bringing students in grades 5-12 to the assembly also.

### Mrs. Aylor, Elementary Principal

- Mrs. Aylor provided a review of opening day activities for staff and PK-4 students. She said that we are off to a great start to the school year.
- The September Newsletter to parents was provided.
- The PK playground that was purchased with last year's 3PK grant fund is almost complete! It looks great.
- Dr. Rose donated \$2500 for kindergarten teachers to purchase materials to help enhance instruction.

# Mrs. Hardy, Director of Technology

- 1:1 Deployment Update
  - 5-12 teachers received their new Dell Laptop This will give teachers a few weeks to get familiar with the device, plan lessons, and be ready for students to receive their laptops November 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - iPads –These are being configured in October, after all student laptops are configured.
- October 6<sup>th</sup> Staff Development Day will be a Tech Day Teachers will have the opportunity to choose what technology professional development they want to attend. Topics were chosen from the technology survey that Mrs. Hardy administered at the beginning of the year.
- New Software for Teachers
  - Seesaw K-4 student driven digital portfolios that can capture student learning in any form to share with parents
  - Flocabulary through CA BOCES Library Coser a learning program for all grades that uses educational hip-hop music to engage students and increase achievement in all curriculum areas
- Ixl for Math concepts Mrs. Hardy is looking into this software. It has unlimited questions on thousands of math topics with real-world scenarios to help students improve math skills.

### Miss Histed, CSE Chair

 12:1:1 BOCES job coaching classroom - What a great opportunity for our Fillmore students to be back in their home school, while still providing them with the support that BOCES offers. Ms. Histed briefly discussed the current instructional focus of the classroom.

### 3.2 Superintendent's Report: Dr. Root

- We have purchased a set of timpani drums from Disney which had only been used for one year there. Ravo has been told by Mrs. Chapman that our current drums are not of the same quality as the Disney drums and they are at least over 20 years old.
- Dr. Root discussed the Section V Athletic Dues and stated that he is the Superintendent representative for the Allegany League and on the finance committee. He worked with a small group of committee members to restructure the dues so they would be based on usage. This is more fair and equitable than the previous formula.
- Just Tell One is a program that has been shared with our teachers on how to respond when a student shares they are suffering from depression, addiction or having suicidal thoughts.
- Dr. Root also attended the NYSCOSS Conference in Saratoga Springs where he
  attended a few workshops about technology and schools that have already
  transitioned to 1 device per 1 student as well as state and federal politics affecting
  schools.

### 3.3 Work Session

The Board of Education reviewed a first reading of a proposed service animal policy #3220 and also reviewed a list of district requirements for all service animals. We have a student with an IEP who is going to start using a therapy dog both in and out of school. Anne Histed and Ravo stated they are working to stay ahead of this matter and make sure we have adopted a school policy along with regulations when it comes to the service dog before it arrives.
